A Regular Meeting of the City Council was held in the Council Chamber, Pico Rivera City Hall, 6615 Passons Boulevard, Pico Rivera, California.

Mayor Camacho called the regular meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. on behalf of the City Council.

- 1. A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Pico Rivera, California, Relating to the Resignation of Councilmember Gregory Salcido and Imposing Certain Directives as Set Forth Herein.**

Mayor Camacho addressed the audience by reading a resolution calling for Councilmember Salcido's resignation in an effort to restore the positive image of the City. He stated that the City Council as a body does not share, endorse or support the personal views expressed by Councilmember Salcido and condemned his point of view expressed towards the United States Military. Council Members spoke in support of the proposed resolution and in favor of a recall. Councilmember Tercero stated that the proposed resolution has no teeth and therefore would be supporting the efforts of a recall instead.

Motion by Councilmember Archuleta, seconded by Councilmember Armenta to approve Resolution No. 6943 relating to the resignation of Councilmember Gregory Salcido and imposing certain directives as set forth herein. Motion carries by the following roll call vote:

- 2. Public Hearing – Introduction of an Ordinance Adding Chapter 4.90 to Implement the Provisions of State Issued Digital Infrastructure and Video Competition Act of 2006 (DIVCA). (1100)**

City Manager Bobadilla stated that the recommendation is to approve the ordinance that would allow the City to continue to impose a franchise fee of five percent of gross revenues, to continue to receive channels for PEG access and to receive a PEG fee equal to one percent of gross revenues in support of PEG programming and associated facilities/equipment.

Motion by Councilmember Armenta, seconded by Councilmember Archuleta to introduce and waive first reading of proposed Ordinance No. 1118 to comply with the Digital Infrastructure and Video Competition Act (DIVCA) which would authorize the City of Pico Rivera to exercise its right thereunder. Motion carries by the following roll call vote:
