Description: Consider a substantial amendment to the 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan. The 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan, which sets forth specific activities and expenditures using funds received through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) programs administered by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), was adopted by the City Council on June 11, 2019.

When a substantial change (i.e. adding an activity, canceling an activity or redirecting funds) is proposed to the City Action Plan, the City requires that the public be notified and a Public Hearing be held to allow the public an opportunity to comment on the proposed substantial changes.

Proposed Amendment to the FY 19 Action Plan: CDBG Program:

The City is proposing to re-program unspent and/or uncommitted funding from this fiscal year to other projects. In addition, the City is proposing to program funds under the CDBG-CARES (CV) program. The City Council will conduct a public hearing to consider the modification in activity funding levels for programs. The following programs may be added, increased, reduced, or eliminated:

Availability of Document for Public Comment: The City of Pico Rivera encourages citizen participation in the planning process. A Public Hearing regarding this proposed Substantial Amendment to the 2019-20 One Year Action Plan will be held on Tuesday, May 12, 2020, 4:00 p.m. via Channel 3 and City's website as noted above.
