

NOTICE INVITING SEALED BIDS FOR THE  
TRAFFIC SIGNAL SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS CITYWIDE  
CITY PROJECT NO. 21305, FEDERAL PROJECT NO. 5351 (030)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Pico Rivera ("City") shall receive sealed bids up to and until 10:00 A.M. on Thursday, August 3, 2017 for the following public works project: TRAFFIC SIGNAL SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS CITYWIDE, CITY PROJECT NO. 21305, FEDERAL PROJECT NO. 5351 (030). The sealed bids shall be clearly marked as SEALED BIDS and be submitted at the offices of the City Clerk located at the Pico Rivera City Hall 6615 Passons Boulevard, Pico Rivera, California 90660.

*The Scope of Work under this contract consists of furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment for the modification of four traffic signals, removal and construction of A.C. and P.C.C. pavement, signing and striping and construction of new P.C.C. sidewalk, curb and gutter, and driveways.*

Bid Packages may be purchased beginning on Monday, July 3, 2017 at the City of Pico Rivera office of the City Clerk in the Department of Administration. The City Clerk's Office is located at City Hall located at 6615 Passons Boulevard, Pico Rivera, CA 90660 and bid packages may be purchased during normal business hours. For information call (562) 801-4350. The cost for the Bid Package is \$50.00 and is non-refundable. There is an additional fee of \$10.00 for mailing bid packages.

The Bidder and each listed subcontractor must have a valid license, issued by the California Contractors State License Board (CSLB), for the type of work proposed to be performed by the Bidder and each listed subcontractor under the contract. This Project requires the Bidder to possess a license classification of "A" (*General Engineering*) and C-10 (*Electrical Contractor*) by the time its bid is submitted to the City in order to be considered a responsive bid.

The undersigned bidder agrees to provide security for the Work included in their contract, including but not limited to, protecting materials, equipment and elements of the project for the duration of their contract and understands that loss or damage is entirely their liability until the Work is completed and accepted by the City. Any contract entered into pursuant to this notice will incorporate the provisions of the State Labor Code. Compliance with the prevailing rates of wages and apprenticeship employment standards established by the State Director of Industrial Relations and the U.S. Department of Labor will be required. Pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code, the State prevailing wage rates for this project have been determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) and are online at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/OPRL/PWD/index.htm>.

A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, subject to the requirements of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or engage in the performance of any contract for public work, as defined in Chapter 1 of Part 7 of

Division 2 of the California Labor Code, unless currently registered and qualified to perform public works pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5. It is not a violation for an unregistered contractor to submit a bid that is authorized by section 7029.1 of the California Business and Professions Code or by section 10164 or 20103.5 of the California Public Contract Code, provided the contractor is registered to perform public work pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5 at the time the contract is awarded. No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public works on a public works project awarded on or after April 1, 2015, unless registered with the DIR. This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the DIR. The Prime Contractor shall post job notices prescribed by the DIR by regulation.

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check, or bidder's bond (executed by a surety company admitted in the State of California), made payable to the City of Pico Rivera for an amount no less than ten percent (10%) of the amount bid as a guarantee that the Bidder, if its proposal is accepted, will enter into a contract and furnish the required bonds within 10 calendar days of the contract award by the City.

Pursuant to Federal law, AGENCY is implementing new Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) requirements to include all DBEs. The DBE requirements are covered in the Specifications in Section 2, "Proposal Requirements and Conditions": subsection 2-1.02, "Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE)"; and in Section 5, "General": subsection 5-1.5, "Performance of DBEs."

The DBE contract goal for this project is 12%.

This project is subject to state contract nondiscrimination and compliance requirements pursuant to Government Code Section 12990. AGENCY affirms that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, DBEs will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation.

*PREVAILING WAGE REQUIREMENTS:* Pursuant to California Labor Code Sections 1770, 1773, 1773.1, 1773.6, and 1773.7, as amended, the applicable prevailing wages for this project have been determined. It shall be mandatory upon the contractor to whom the contract is awarded and upon any subcontractor under him to pay not less than the higher of the Federal and the State prevailing wage rates to all workers employed by them in the execution of the contract. The applicable Federal prevailing wage rates are those that are in effect ten (10) calendar days prior to bid opening; they are set forth on the U.S. Department of Labor website: <http://www.wdol.gov/wdol/scafiles/davisbacon/ca33.dvb> but are not printed in the Specifications. Lower State wage rates for work classifications not specifically listed in the Federal wage decision are not acceptable. The applicable State prevailing wage rates are set forth on the California Department of Industrial Relations website: <http://www.dir.ca.gov/DLSR/PWD> but are not printed in the Specifications; these rates are subject to predetermined increases.
