



NOTICE INVITING SEALED BIDS

FOR THE

ANNUAL SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT NO. 21330

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Pico Rivera ("City") shall receive sealed bids up to and until **11:00 A.M. on Tuesday, December 15, 2015** for the following public works project: **ANNUAL SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS, CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT NO. 21330** (hereinafter, the "Project"). The sealed bids shall be clearly marked as **SEALED BIDS** and be submitted at the offices of the City Clerk located at the Pico Rivera City Hall 6615 Passons Boulevard, Pico Rivera, California 90660. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the above-mentioned office. The Project is located in numerous residential streets throughout the City. For the purpose of this Notice Inviting Sealed Bids, the location of the Project may hereinafter be referred to as the "Project Site".

Prebid questions regarding the contract documents shall be directed to Jose Loera at (562) 801-4350. **Prebid questions will not be accepted less than four (4) business days before the date of the bid opening.**

Description of Work

The Scope of Work under this contract consists of furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment for the removal of existing PCC sidewalk; clearing and grubbing; root trimming; and construction of new PCC sidewalk.

The bidder shall have knowledge of the existing conditions in the Project Areas, which affect the cost of work, and his signature on the Proposal shall be considered by the City to be evidenced of this knowledge.

Construction Schedule

After notification of award, and prior to the start of any work, the Contractor shall submit to the City Engineer for approval, a proposed construction schedule in accordance with

the Specifications and Special Provisions. The Work shall be completed in **20 working days**.

Plans. Special Provisions. and Contract Documents

Bid Packages may be purchased beginning on **Thursday, November 19, 2015** at the City of Pico Rivera office of the City Clerk in the Department of Administration. (hereinafter, the "City Clerk's Office"). The City Clerk's Office is located at City Hall located at 6615 Passons Boulevard, Pico Rivera, CA 90660 and bid packages may be purchased during normal business hours. A reference set of plans, specifications and contract documents are also available for review at the public counter of the Engineering Office. For information call (562) 801-2436. The cost for the Bid Package is **\$25.00 and is non-refundable**. There is an additional fee of \$10.00 for mailing bid packages.

In order to receive notifications for addenda to the contract documents, Bidders must purchase a bid package and register as a Plan holder at the City Clerk's Office. All addenda must be signed, acknowledging receipt, by the Bidder and included in the Bid submittal.

Submittal of Bids

One (1) original fully executed copy of the bid documents may be **MAILED, DELIVERED IN PERSON or by COURIER (Monday-Thursday between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm)** in a sealed envelope clearly labeled on the outside in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders to the following location:

It is the responsibility of the Bidder to ensure that the bid is received by the City prior to the bid due date and time regardless of the delivery method. The time stamp at the City Clerk's Counter will document the actual time of receipt. Late proposals will NOT be considered and will be returned to the Bidder unopened, at the sole discretion of the City. **Telegraphic, electronic, emailed, and facsimile bid documents will NOT be accepted.**

The Bidder and each listed subcontractor must have a valid license, issued by the California Contractors State License Board (CSLB), for the type of work proposed to be performed by the Bidder and each listed subcontractor under the contract. This Project requires the Bidder to possess a license classification of **"A" (General Engineering) Contractor's License or "C8" (Concrete)** by the time its bid is submitted to the City in order to be considered a responsive bid.

The undersigned bidder agrees to provide security for the Work included in their contract, including but not limited to, protecting materials, equipment and elements of

the project for the duration of their contract and understands that loss or damage is entirely their liability until the Work is completed and accepted by the City.

Any contract entered into pursuant to this notice will incorporate the provisions of the State Labor Code. Compliance with the prevailing rates of wages and apprenticeship employment standards established by the State Director of Industrial Relations and the U.S. Department of Labor will be required. Pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code, the State prevailing wage rates for this project have been determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) and are online at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/OPRL/PWD/index.htm>.

A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, subject to the requirements of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or engage in the performance of any contract for public work, as defined in Chapter 1 of Part 7 of Division 2 of the California Labor Code, unless currently registered and qualified to perform public works pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5. It is not a violation for an unregistered contractor to submit a bid that is authorized by section 7029.1 of the California Business and Professions Code or by section 10164 or 20103.5 of the California Public Contract Code, provided the contractor is registered to perform public work pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5 at the time the contract is awarded. No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public works on a public works project awarded on or after April 1, 2015, unless registered with the DIR. This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the DIR. The Prime Contractor shall post job notices prescribed by the DIR by regulation.

Affirmative action to ensure against discrimination in employment practices on the basis of race, color, national origin, ancestry, sex or religion will also be required.

The City of Pico Rivera, in keeping with applicable laws and adopted City policies, will ensure that minority owned business enterprises are afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this notice and will not be discriminated against on the basis of race, color, national origin, ancestry, sex or religion in any consideration leading to the award of the contract.

In entering into a public works contract, or a subcontract, to supply goods, services or materials pursuant to a public works contract, the Contractor, or subcontractor, offers and agrees to assign to the awarding body all rights, title, interest in, and to, all causes of action it may have under Section 4 of the Clayton Act (15 U.S.C. Section 15) or under the Cartwright Act (Chapter 2 [commencing with Section 167001 of Part 2 of Division 7 of the Business and Professions Code), arising from purchased of goods, services or materials pursuant to the public works contract or the subcontract. This assignment shall be made and become effective at the time the awarding body tenders final payment to the Contractor, without further acknowledgement by the parties.


Bids must be prepared on the approved Proposal Schedule in compliance with the Instructions to Bidders and submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked on the outside with the Bidder's name and the name of the Project.

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check, or bidder's bond (executed by a surety company admitted in the State of California), made payable to the City of Pico Rivera for an amount no less than ten percent (10%) of the amount bid as a guarantee that the Bidder, if its proposal is accepted, will enter into a contract and furnish the required bonds within 10 calendar days of the contract award by the City.

Pursuant to the California Waste Management Act of 1989 (AS 939), Contractor's undertaking certain construction, demolition and renovation projects shall submit and adhere to a Waste Management Plan, as described in Ordinance No. 972 of the City of Pico Rivera.

The City of Pico Rivera reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularity, and to take all bids under advisement for a period of (90) ninety calendar days for any reason deemed to be in the best interests of the City of Pico Rivera.
