

**NOTICE INVITING SEALED BIDS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Pico Rivera ("City") shall receive sealed bids up to and until **10:00 A.M. on Thursday, January 28, 2016** for the following public works project: **ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS CITYWIDE, CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT NO. 21333, FEDERAL PROJECT NO. B-15-MC-06-0526**. This project is funded by a **Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)**. The sealed bids shall be clearly marked as **SEALED BIDS** and be submitted at the offices of the City Clerk located at the Pico Rivera City Hall 6615 Passons Boulevard, Pico Rivera, California 90660.

Prebid questions regarding the contract documents shall be directed to Robert Delgadillo at (562) 801-4364. **Prebid questions will not be accepted less than four (4) business days before the date of the bid opening.**

**Description of Work**

***The Scope of Work under this contract consists of furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment for the removal of existing A.C. and P.C.C pavement, removal and construction on new P.C.C. curb and gutter, sidewalk, and driveways.*** The work shall be completed in **25** working days.

**Special Provisions. and Contract Documents**

Bid Packages may be purchased beginning on **Monday, December 28, 2015** at the City of Pico Rivera office of the City Clerk in the Department of Administration. The City Clerk's Office is located at City Hall located at 6615 Passons Boulevard, Pico Rivera, CA 90660 and bid packages may be purchased during normal business hours.

**In order to receive notifications for addenda to the contract documents, Bidders must purchase a bid package and register as a Planholder at the City Clerk's Office. All addenda must be signed, acknowledging receipt, by the Bidder and included in the Bid submittal.**

The Bidder and each listed subcontractor must have a valid license, issued by the California Contractors State License Board (CSLB), for the type of work proposed to be

performed by the Bidder and each listed subcontractor under the contract. This Project requires the Bidder to possess a license classification of **"A" (General Engineering) Contractor's License** or **"C32" (Parking and Highway Improvements)** by the time its bid is submitted to the City in order to be considered a responsive bid.

Any contract entered into pursuant to this notice will incorporate the provisions of the State Labor Code. Compliance with the prevailing rates of wages and apprenticeship employment standards established by the State Director of Industrial Relations and the U.S. Department of Labor will be required. Pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code, the State prevailing wage rates for this project have been determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) and are online at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/OPRL/PWD/index.htm>.

This project is Federally funded and is subject to the Davis-Bacon Act. Compliance with the Davis-Bacon Act (40 U.S.C. 276a to 276a-7) as supplemented by Department of Labor regulations (29 CFR part 5) is required. The Davis-Bacon Act requires the payment of prevailing wage rates (which are determined by the U.S. Department of Labor) on Federally funded projects. The prime contractor and all subcontractors are required to pay their laborers and mechanics under this contract a wage not less than the highest wage applicable for their work classification, as specified in the Federal General Wage Decision Number CA150033, dated December 11, 2015. Federal wage decision is not attached and can be downloaded from <http://www.wdol.gov>. Bidders are responsible for using the correct wage decision. An error on the part of any awarding body does not relieve the contractor from the responsibility for payment of the correct prevailing wage and penalties, pursuant to the provisions and sections of Labor Code (1770-1776).

A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, subject to the requirements of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or engage in the performance of any contract for public work, as defined in Chapter 1 of Part 7 of Division 2 of the California Labor Code, unless currently registered and qualified to perform public works pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5. It is not a violation for an unregistered contractor to submit a bid that is authorized by section 7029.1 of the California Business and Professions Code or by section 10164 or 20103.5 of the California Public Contract Code, provided the contractor is registered to perform public work pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5 at the time the contract is awarded. No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public works on a public works project awarded on or after April 1, 2015, unless registered with the DIR. This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the DIR. The Prime Contractor shall post job notices prescribed by the DIR by regulation.

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check, or bidder's bond (executed by a surety company admitted in the State of California), made payable to the City of Pico Rivera for an amount no less than ten percent (10%) of the amount bid as a guarantee that the Bidder, if its proposal is accepted, will enter into a contract and furnish the required bonds within 10 calendar days of the contract award by the City.

The City of Pico Rivera reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularity, and to take all bids under advisement for a period of (90) ninety calendar days for any reason deemed to be in the best interests of the City of Pico Rivera.
