



NOTICE INVITING SEALED BIDS

PICO RIVERA WATER AUTHORITY ELECTRICAL PANEL REPLACEMENT AT PLANT NO. 2 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT NO. 21297

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Pico Rivera Water Authority ("PRWA") shall receive sealed bids up to and until **2:00 P.M. on Tuesday, July 26, 2016** for the following public works project: **PICO RIVERA WATER AUTHORITY (PRWA) ELECTRICAL PANEL REPLACEMENT AT PLANT NO. 2 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT NO. 21297** (hereinafter, the Project"). The sealed bids shall be clearly marked as **SEALED BIDS** and be submitted at the offices of the City Clerk located at Pico Rivera City Hall 6615 Passons Boulevard, Pico Rivera, California 90660. The bids will be publicly opened and read at 2:00 P.M. on July 26, 2016 at the above-mentioned office of the Owner.

Description of Work

The Scope of Work under this contract consists of furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment for upgrading the existing Motor Control Center at Plant No. 2 for Pico Rivera Water Authority. The work will include but not limited to the construction of a new connection to the utility service pole, construction of a new transformer pad per Southern California Edison (SCE) requirements, construction of a new service entrance/Main Switchboard (MSB-1), demolition of the existing Motor Control center and the installation of a new Motor Control Center (MCC-A) in accordance with the Contract Documents.

The bidder shall have knowledge of the existing conditions in the Project Areas, which affect the cost of work, and his or her signature on the Proposal shall be considered by the PRWA to be evidenced of this knowledge.

Pre-Bid Conference

Prospective bidders are encouraged to attend a conference with the Owner and Owner's representatives at **10:00 A.M. on July 13, 2016** at the PRWA Plant No. 2 located at 8316 Washington Boulevard, Pico Rivera, California 90660. The purpose will be to discuss the scope of work to be performed under these specifications. Questions

Plans. Special Provisions. and Contract Documents

Bid Packages may be purchased beginning on **Wednesday, June 22, 2016** at the City of Pico Rivera office of the City Clerk in the Department of Administration (hereinafter, the "City Clerk's Office"). The City Clerk's Office is located at City Hall located at 6615 Passons Boulevard, Pico Rivera, CA 90660 and bid packages may be purchased during normal business hours. A reference set of plans, specifications and contract documents are also available for review at the public counter of the Engineering Office. For information call (562) 801- 4389. The cost for the Bid Package is **\$50.00 and is non-refundable**. There is an additional fee of \$10.00 for mailing bid packages.

In order to receive notifications for addenda to the contract documents, Bidders must purchase a bid package and register as a Planholder at the City Clerk's Office.

Submittal of Bids

It is the responsibility of the Bidder to ensure that the bid is received by the City prior to the bid due date and time regardless of the delivery method. The time stamp at the City Clerk's Counter will document the actual time of receipt. Late proposals will NOT be considered and will be returned to the Bidder unopened, at the sole discretion of the City. **Telegraphic, electronic, emailed, and facsimile bid documents will NOT be accepted.**

The Bidder and each listed subcontractor must have a valid license, issued by the California Contractors State License Board (CSLB), for the type of work proposed to be performed by the Bidder and each listed subcontractor under the contract. This Project requires the Bidder to possess a license classification of **"C10" (Electrical) Contractor's License** by the time its bid is submitted to the City in order to be considered a responsive bid.

Any contract entered into pursuant to this notice will incorporate the provisions of the State Labor Code. Compliance with the prevailing rates of wages and apprenticeship employment standards established by the State Director of Industrial Relations and the U.S. Department of Labor will be required. Pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code, the State prevailing wage rates for this project have been determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) and are online at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/OPRL/PWD/index.htm>.

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check, or bidder's bond (executed by a surety company admitted in the State of California), made payable to the City of Pico Rivera for an amount no less than ten percent (10%) of the amount bid as a guarantee that the Bidder, if its proposal is accepted, will enter into a contract and furnish the required bonds within 10 calendar days of the contract award by the City.
