You may soon be affected by the construction of the County of Los Angeles Department of Public Works San Gabriel River Coastal Spreading Grounds Pump Station Pipeline and Mines Avenue Recycled Water Pipeline project. Inside are details concerning this project. SAN GABRIEL RIVER COASTAL SPREADING GROUNDS PUMP STATION PIPELINE AND MINES AVENUE RECYCLED WATER PIPELINE

LOCATION

PURPOSE

This action involves the construction of 78-inch diameter reinforced concrete pipeline, 8-inch diameter ductile iron recycled water irrigation pipeline, junction structures, manholes, and other appurtenant work. This project is part of Public Works' ongoing program for the construction of water conservation facilities.

JURISDICTION

The project is located within the City of Pico Rivera. The plans were prepared by the County of Los Angeles Department of Public Works and Central Basin Municipal Water District (CBMWD) for the 78-inch pipeline and 8-inch pipeline respectively. A private contractor will construct the project with inspection provided by Public Works. The 78" pipeline will be maintained by Public Works, and the 8" pipeline will be maintained by CBMWD after its completion.

PUBLIC IMPACT

Access to homes will not be restricted during this project. The contractor shall make necessary arrangements with the County and provide the necessary construction signing, barricading, delineators, flashing arrow signs, and flagging required for this project.

Construction will include the use of excavators, trucks, and other equipment. We will attempt to minimize the inconvenience to the public. However, the construction equipment may generate some noise and vibrations. To avoid serious accidents, we urge parents to keep their children and pets away from the construction area and the equipment. We ask for your cooperation and patience during construction.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Construction of this project is scheduled to begin on October 8th, 2009 and be completed September 9th, 2010. Typically, working hours will be from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. however on Rosemead Boulevard will be between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m. and on Paramount Boulevard and Mines Avenue the work will be from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
