Rivera Park proposal

Smith Park proposal



LOCATION	6016 Rosemead Blvd
STATUS	Community Outreach Phase
COMMUNITY MEETING	6 PM on Wednesday, October 6, 2009 Senior Center Auditorium
DESCRIPTION	Renovation plans for Smith Park include new soccer and ball fields, lights, playground, restrooms, parking, concession stands, walking paths, and picnic areas. The project includes renovating adjacent school grounds for park activities.
TIMELINE	Timing for construction has not yet been established.
ESTIMATED COST	6.5 Million

Civic Plaza on Mines Avenue proposal



LOCATION	Mines Avenue at Rosemead Boulevard
STATUS	Community Outreach Phase

DESCRIPTION	Renovation plans include closing Mines Avenue from Lindsey Ave. to Rosemead Blvd. to create a civic plaza that will link a new library to Smith Park.

ESTIMATED COST	4 Million
