REACH is accepting applications for 1st thru 5th graders at all 8 elementary schools in the El Rancho Unified School District.

REACH packets will be available Monday, July 6, 2009
and must be walked in to the Department of Parks & Recreation.

REACH applications require a \$20 registration fee for the 2009-2010 school year.

The fee is \$20 *per student* and is non-refundable. The fee is due upon enrollment in the program. A new registration fee is applied to each new program each year. Assistance is available for low-income families.

REACH walk-in registration begins Monday, July 13, 2009 from 8:00 a.m. until 6:30 p.m. and ends Friday July 17, 2009.

80 students will be accepted per site based on a lottery held on July 20 and July 21. Names will be pulled in order until enrollment has reached maximum capacity. Remaining applicants will be pulled and placed on a waiting list in order.
