Mayor Tercero called the regular meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. on behalf of the City Council.

Beverly Walker:

- Addressed the City Council regarding upcoming Candidate Forum and encouraged residents to take the opportunity to experience the new mock voting system at Pico Park this weekend.

Jose Sanchez:

- Addressed the City Council regarding damage caused by thumping and vibrations on Rosemead Boulevard due to heavy vehicle traffic and poor street conditions.

Lauren Talbott, Pico Rivera Community Library Manager:

Deputy Director Heredia addressed the speakers concerns pertaining to Rosemead Boulevard by stating that staff would be seeking the assistance of a consultant who has the expertise to assess and analyze the road condition for repair. Councilmember Elias mentioned his concerns with vagrancy, calls for service, registered complaints for neglect and lack of supervision for the residents of the Pico Rivera Gardens state facility.

Mayor Tercero in collaboration with City Attorney Alvarez-Glasman stated that the issues brought up by Councilmember Elias would be discussed at the next City Council meeting in Closed Session under Anticipated Litigation. Mayor Tercero further stated that remedies, full reports and chronology would be provided at this meeting.
