WHITTIER NARROWS DAM SAFETY MODIFICATION PROJECT **UPDATE FOR PICO RIVERA CITY COUNCIL**

Purpose: Address foundation and overtopping concerns that could lead to failure of the dam and significant loss of life.

Timing: Major construction anticipated between 2025 and 2029





Raising Rosemead/Lincoln, additional staging along Durfee, purchase of

- **4 Years of Major Construction Anticipated**
- Will result in closures of recreational features/Sports Arena Drive during construction, but welcome new out-grants afterwards

Importance to Pico Rivera

National expertise for state-of-the-art dam safety engineering

Design to ensure utilities / roads are relocated or maintained.

- Construction equipment will be visible and audible
- Traffic along Rosemead/Lincoln to be impacted

Whittier Narrows is a USACE Priority

concrete swale adjacent to Rio Hondo

Opportunity to re-establish driving range

Between 2023 and 2024

- Public outreach and engagement will be a focus
- Ensure understanding of how the dam works
- Ensure understanding of this investment
- Raise flood awareness, support emergency planning and response

USACE to support Pico Rivera's outreach

- Participate in community events
- Support emergency planning and preparedness
- Engage in media and outreach events

Key Updates

Safety Project Status

- Senior dam safety officials have been integrated into the team
- Major Construction to Start in 2025 vs 2022
- Minor changes in the project design

Purpose of the Dam Safety Project

- Address safety concerns that could cause the dam to fail
- Active construction on top of dam and downstream face of dam and space between the dam and the houses.

Focus on existing Utility Relocation Contract 1
