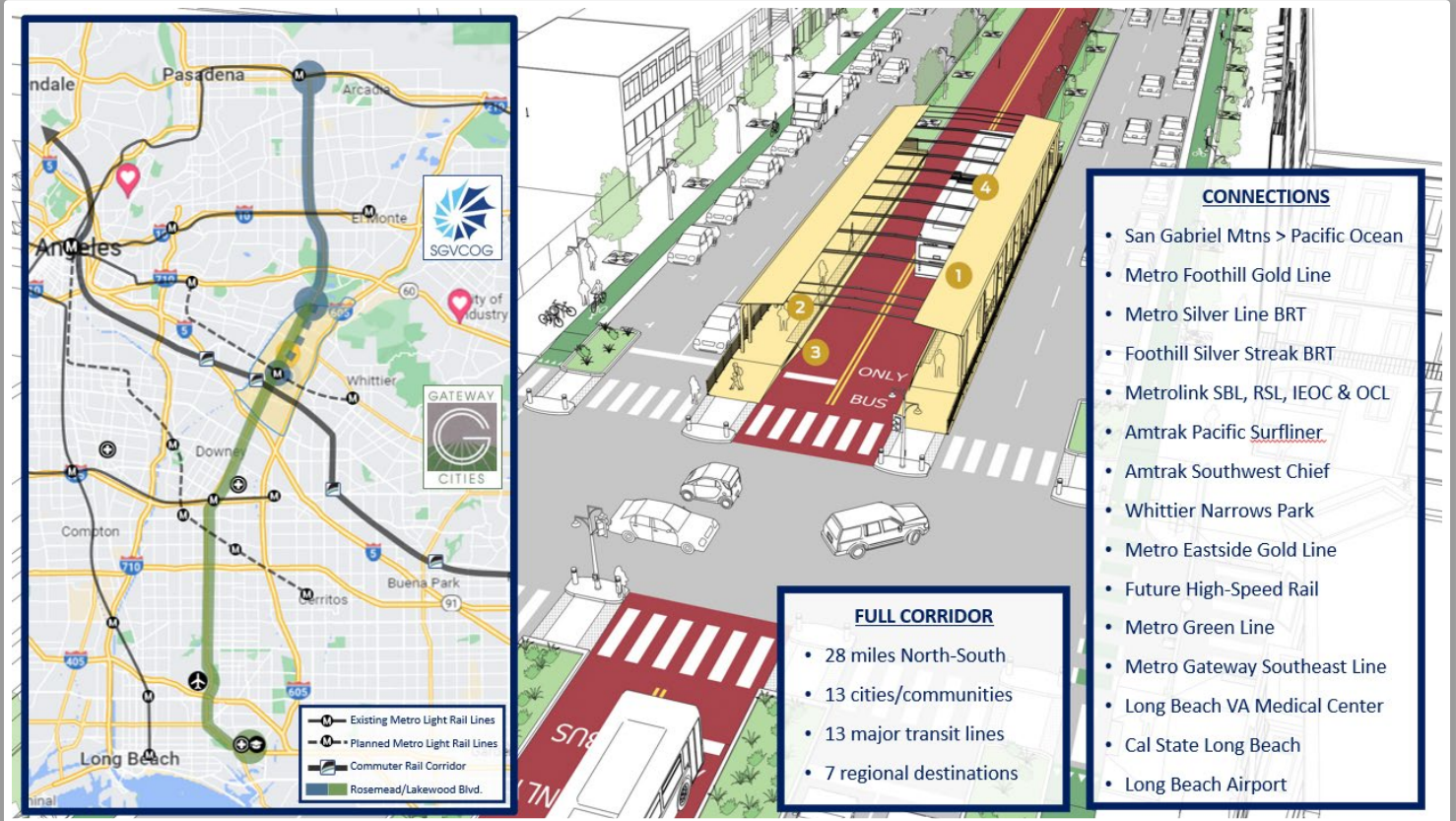




Rosemead/Lakewood Blvd. Complete Corridor Project (ATP+BRT+TOD)






